




DO NOT BRING AFRICAN SWINE FEVER TO JAMAICA

Always **DECLARE** all food including pork products on your **Customs C5 Card.**

If you have recently visited or worked on a farm outside of Jamaica, YOUR FOOTWEAR AND OR CLOTHING MIGHT BE CONTAMINATED.





It is against the law not to declare food items.


Don't Bring ASF To Jamaica!

 Declare all food and animal products on your Customs C5 Card.



 ASF can be carried on clothing, shoes, hands, equipment, tools, used vehicles including used tractor tyres.



 If you have visited a farm overseas, when you return to Jamaica, please inform the Customs Officer.
 Do not visit a pig farm or other location with pigs.
