

An analysis of animal performance and carcass characteristics of beef cattle weaners on feedlot

[Abstract]

Weaners from four Jamaica cattle breeds and crossbreeds were evaluated for a one year period. Animals started on test averaging nine months old with initial weights ranging from 500-600 lbs for males and 450-500 for females. Average weight at slaughter for males was 1000 lbs while heifers averaged 925 lbs. Three references.
