Symmetrischima capsicum (Povolny): Gelechidae) a new pest for Jamaica.

[Abstract]

Recently, larvae of the pepper bud moth, *Symmetrischema capsicum* have been found feeding within the buds of cultivated pepper in Jamaica. Ninety-four percent of hot pepper farms sampled were infested with an average infestation of 21.9%. Larval infestation was found in *Capsicum chinense* (Scotch Bonnet, West Indian Red) and *Capsicum annum* (Sweet pepper, Jalapeno pepper). The small larvae feed upon the reproductive structures causing the buds to fall off or fail to produce fruit.
